Selection Criteria:

- High School Senior Girl
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Attending community college, university, or accredited private or technical school starting in the Fall 2017
- Community Service/Volunteerism
- Good Citizenship
- May not be a member or employee of Soroptimist International or immediate family member of either.

Application Requirements:

- Completed Application
- Essay

Amount of Award: \$1,000*
